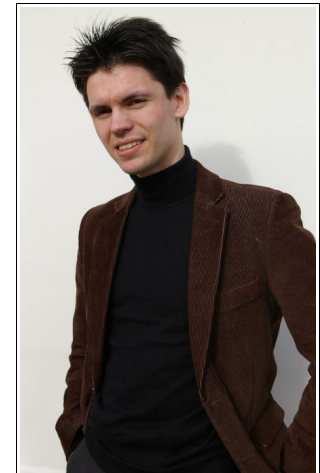

This was done by making individual tests possible and adding a release schedule. CMDB , both worked on the front-end and backend of the internal CMDB solution, and made hooks to out central management system so a change in CMDB would reflect the actual installation.
